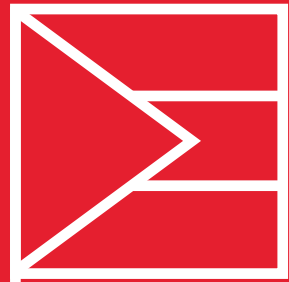

The UK Government’s Witch Hunt Against Palestine Advocates

Across all aspects of society, the UK government and politicians have launched a wholesale witch hunt against Palestinians and advocates of Palestine by repeatedly associating support for Palestinian liberation with terrorism and antisemitism.²

This discrimination has also extended to the UK’s national broadcaster, the BBC, which has uncritically reproduced both the government’s and Israeli narratives surrounding Palestine advocacy to ensure the dissemination of disinformation and misunderstanding amongst the UK public.³

Consequently, the UK government has increasingly emboldened pro-Israeli lobby groups to launch smear campaigns against Palestine advocates across all sectors of society, and has repeatedly spoken out in favour of these complaints, putting pressure on regulatory bodies to investigate clearly false allegations.⁴

This sustained campaign of discrimination and repression has escalated with the government’s classification of Palestine Action and direct action activists for Palestine as terrorists – despite widespread criticism from human rights organisations and the public – and even manipulating the court system in order to enforce terrorism sentences against activists without the oversight of a jury.⁵

Combined, this concerted, institutionalised effort to criminalise, deplatform, and defame advocates of Palestine amounts to state terrorism by the UK against those campaigning for Palestinian rights, intended to force them into silence and prevent other figures from speaking out, as well as reduce public awareness and understanding of Israel’s genocide in Palestine.⁶

“The Elbit four will be labelled as “terrorists” because they were convicted, in substance, of a quasi-terrorist offence that was never charged, never put to the jury, and never proven by the prosecution. The jurors who found them guilty of criminal damage had no idea their verdict would be treated as a verdict on terrorism. The prosecution was not required to establish the terrorist connection beyond reasonable doubt, or to any standard at all.”

Sentencing the Filton 25 as Terrorists

The UK government has retrospectively weaponised their proscription of the direct action group Palestine Action in order to sentence members of the Filton 25 as terrorists, despite the organisation not being proscribed at the time of their action against Elbit Systems, Israel’s largest weapons producer.⁸

On 12 June 2026, a UK court decided to sentence four members of the Filton 25 as terrorists for saving lives by destroying killer drones destined to join the genocidal arsenal of the Israeli Occupation Forces (IOF).⁹

Fatema, Lottie, Ellie, and Sam were sentenced for between five and eight years by Justice Johnson, despite the jury who convicted them of criminal damage not being made aware that they would be sentenced as terrorists.¹⁰

Ordinarily, an offence of criminal damage would only result in a fine or sentence of around 18 months.¹¹

The prosecution was not required to establish the terrorist connection beyond reasonable doubt, or to any standard at all.¹² The ruling is, in this sense, entirely the personal political decision of Justice Johnson.¹³

Upon their release, the defendants will be classified as terrorists, forcing them to notify police of possession of any new electronic device, bank account, email address, or car registration for up to 15 years.¹⁴ Any mistake or failure to comply could result in them being sent back to prison.¹⁵

The UK government’s repeated terrorising of the Filton 25 is intended to have a chilling effect on direct action in the UK that attempts to undermine the IOF’s genocide in Palestine.¹⁶

Dr Ghassan Abu Sittah

Dr Ghassan Abu Sittah is a renowned British Palestinian doctor specialising in reconstructive plastic surgery and war-related injuries, who has volunteered to provide medical treatment in various warzones, including Iraq, Lebanon, Syria, Yemen, and the besieged Gaza Strip – both during the current genocide and in previous Israeli attacks.¹⁸

Following his lifesaving work with Doctors Without Borders (MSF) in Al-Awda, Al-Shifa, and Al-Ahli hospitals in the besieged Gaza Strip for 43 days from 9 October 2023, the pro-Israel lobby group UK Lawyers for Israel (UKLFI) submitted a complaint to the General Medical Council (GMC) that Dr Abu

Sittah had “impaired his fitness to practice” due to an article he had authored in Lebanese newspaper *Al Akhbar* and tweets he had reposted.¹⁹

For almost a year, the GMC continued to entertain this clear witch hunt against him, before finally concluding that neither his article nor reposts supported violence, terrorism, or antisemitism, nor had the intention to do so.²⁰

This sustained harassment also included legal efforts to block him from travelling in the Schengen Area, as well as his GMC case.²¹

Dr Rahmeh Aladwan

Dr Rahmeh Aladwan, a British-Palestinian-Jordanian NHS doctor, has been subjected to a relentless Zionist smear campaign.²²

She will stand trial in 2027 for tweeting “I don’t condemn Hamas. I don’t condemn October 7. I condemn the existence of Israel”, among other social media posts. She has also been accused of using “threatening or abusive insulting words” at a Palestine protest in London.²³

Dr Aladwan has been suspended from practising until the outcome of her trial. She has also been referred twice by the GMC to medical tribunals intended to prevent her from working, despite receiving zero patient complaints in her years of medical practice.²⁴

Dr Aladwan was directly targeted by pro-Israel MP and Health Secretary Wes Streeting, who said her “sickening comments” had no place in the NHS “and action needs to be taken to root the evil of racism out”.²⁵ Streeting also said he would overhaul the way medical regulators investigate cases of antisemitism.²⁶

Dr Nadeem Crowe

Dr Nadeem Crowe is a British-Jordanian A&E doctor who was suspended mid-shift from working at an NHS Trust for his anti-Zionist posts on X that compared Israel to the Nazis and expressed support for Palestinians, after a colleague complained about his social media posts.²⁷

His suspension was lifted after two days, but he has stopped working at the hospital after feeling that he could not trust his colleagues.²⁸

Attacks on Healthcare Workers

Dr Ranjeet Brar

On 6 April 2026, Dr Ranjeet Brar, director of Right to Protest Limited, was suspended by King’s College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust, for a statement made against Israel’s illegal war on Iran and genocide, during his speech at a memorial event for 186 primary schoolchildren murdered in a ‘double tap’ strike on a school in Minab, Iran.⁹⁰

Dr Brar has brought a judicial review to challenge how the non-statutory IHRA definition of antisemitism has been adopted and applied within the NHS and other public bodies.⁹¹

The High Court challenge raises issues of constitutional importance, including freedom of expression, procedural fairness, equality and non-discrimination, and the proper limits of relying on non-statutory guidance in public decision-making.⁹²

Chelsea and Westminster Hospital

In February 2023, UKLFI launched a complaint against an display of artwork by Palestinian children in the besieged Gaza Strip at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital.⁸⁶

The display of decorated plates, designed by children at two United Nations schools in Gaza and accompanied by brief explanations, was on show at the entrance to the children’s outpatients department.⁸⁷

The complaint ridiculously suggested that the display made Jewish patients feel “vulnerable, harassed and victimised”.⁸⁸

The display was permanently removed a few days later.⁸⁹

“My immediate thoughts are with my patients in Beirut, whom I was forced to leave in order to attend these proceedings. I have spent my entire medical career treating the victims of war and political violence. [...] I can tell you what a child’s face looks like when half of it has been blown away, and what it means to spend an entire night amputating the limbs of children in an overcrowded hospital.

This complaint forms part of a broader lawfare strategy which aims to instrumentalise the regulatory processes to intimidate, silence, and exhaust those who speak out against injustice in Palestine. This was the second complaint made against me to the GMC by UK Lawyers for Israel, and the tenth complaint made by them overall.”

Dr Shahd Abusalama

In 2022, Palestinian academic Dr Shahd Abusalama faced a witch hunt by Zionists following her hiring by Sheffield Hallam University.³⁰

Just three days into her employment, the university launched an investigation into comments Dr Abusalama made on social media in which she defended a first-year student who had made a poster using the phrase “stop the Palestinian Holocaust”.³¹ Colleagues mounted a campaign in defence of Dr Abusalama, and the investigation was dropped shortly after it began.³²

Later that year, another false allegation of antisemitism was made against Dr Abusalama, which was also found to be without evidence.³³

This targeted campaign was also advanced by the *Jewish Chronicle*, which attempted to smear her decades-old tweets and depict her as a ‘terrorist’ sympathiser.³⁴

A senior university official then went to the *Jewish Chronicle* to address her case, despite a confidentiality agreement being signed between Dr Abusalama and the university when she left her post.³⁵

Professor David Miller

David Miller was a professor of Political Sociology at the University of Bristol who was targeted by a concerted effort from groups and individuals opposed to his anti-Zionist views, which attempted to smear him as antisemitic.³⁶

The smear campaign began after Professor Miller delivered a lecture on Islamophobia, arguing that the Zionist movement was one of five pillars driving Islamophobia in the UK, and escalated after he took part in an online event in 2021 entitled “Building the Campaign for Free Speech.”³⁷ Professor Miller critiqued Zionist movements and linked Jewish student groups in the UK to political agendas aligned with Israel.³⁸

He was subjected to a discriminatory and unfair misconduct proceedings that led to his dismissal from the university.³⁹

After taking the university to court for unfair and wrongful dismissal, an employment tribunal ruled in Professor Miller’s favour.⁴⁰

Notably, the tribunal found that Professor Miller’s anti-Zionist beliefs qualified as a “philosophical belief and a protected characteristic” under the Equality Act 2010.⁴¹ This was the first time that anti-Zionism was established as a protected belief under UK law, setting an important precedent for later legal cases.⁴²

The tribunal also found that Professor Miller was subject to “direct discrimination” from the university over its decision to terminate his employment.⁴³

“Increasing pressure on supporters of [the] Palestinian cause is an attempt to silence legitimate criticism. It’s an attempt to try and get us to stop scrutinizing the actions of the Israeli state.”

SOAS 2

The SOAS 2 were arrested for speeches delivered at SOAS University students’ Palestine protest, in which they defended Palestinians’ right to resistance, days after Israel began its genocide in the besieged Gaza Strip.⁴⁵

After Zionist X accounts urged the Metropolitan Police to act and submitted a formal complaint, they were arrested and face up to 14 years imprisonment.⁴⁶

LSE 7

Seven students from LSE were suspended and banned from campus following campus protests against LSE’s complicity in Israel’s genocide in the besieged Gaza Strip.⁴⁷ LSE singled out seven of the participating students, banned them from campus, and initiated disciplinary proceedings against them.⁴⁸ Many of these students were forced to defer their studies as a result.⁴⁹

Usama Ghanem

Usama Ghanem is a second year Egyptian student from King’s College London (KCL), who has been targeted for his participation in Palestine protests and encampments.⁵⁰

He was singled out in a complaint from the pro-Israel lobby group Campaign Against Antisemitism, who demanded that KCL suspend and discipline him for his role in the protests.⁵¹

He was suspended from studying for a year, and may be suspended indefinitely, which would place his visa in jeopardy and force him to return to Egypt, where he and his family have faced torture and political persecution.⁵²

Dana Abuqamar

In December 2023, Dana Abuqamar, a 19-year-old Palestinian law student who had 15 family members killed in the Gaza genocide, had her student visa revoked due to her public statements at a pro-Palestine protest.⁵³

In October 2024, Abuqamar won her appeal against the Home Office’s decision to revoke her visa.⁵⁴

“We see in Palestine what the Zionists want to do with academia [...] and we see that is the context for all of the attacks they’ve been making over many years in the West, and of course in the UK. This is a live issue, which is having a deeper and deeper effect in the UK, in terms of people’s jobs lost, students expelled, visas denied. There is a dramatic increase in pressure on academics and students in universities.”

Misan Harriman

In May 2026, pro-Israel lobby groups including the Campaign Against Antisemitism launched a witch hunt to sack the Chair of the Southbank Centre and Oscar-nominated photographer, Misan Harriman, for his anti-Zionist beliefs and Palestine advocacy.⁵⁶

Following complaints made by the Campaign Against Antisemitism, Britain’s Zionist media outlets intensified the smear campaign, with their allegations amplified by *The Telegraph*, *GB News*, *The Daily Mail*, *The Daily Express*, and *The Jewish Chronicle*.⁵⁷

A record 80,000+ people submitted complaints to a UK media watchdog against right-wing media outlets for their smear campaign.⁵⁸

This was followed by further smear attempts by Reform Party Shadow Chancellor Robert Jenrick and Labour MP David Taylor, who both suggested that he should be removed from his position at the Southbank Centre.⁵⁹

Matthew Collings

In May 2026, Matthew Collings’ art exhibition, *Drawings Against Genocide*, was cancelled after a complaint by UK Lawyers for Israel (UKFLI) that the images were antisemitic, despite a police force finding no evidence this was the case.⁶⁰

The smear campaign was also promoted by Sunday Telegraph columnist Zoe Striml, who also promoted this fictitious narrative of antisemitism on *GB News*.⁶¹

Gary Lineker

Gary Lineker, a former England football player and long-time presenter of popular UK football show, *Match of the Day*, was forced to leave the BBC after sharing a social media post against Zionism that pro-Israel groups falsely labelled antisemitic.⁶²

This followed previous witch hunts against Lineker for supporting refugees and criticising the government’s asylum policy, following which he was suspended from presenting.⁶³ Prior to stepping down, he had also signed an open letter to the BBC, alongside over 500 other high-profile individuals, urging the BBC to reinstate its documentary on Gaza that had been scrapped from iPlayer.⁶⁴

“Since art and culture have the potential of reaching larger audiences, they would be a strategic target for those actors sustaining Israel’s genocide and settler colonialism, to make sure Palestine is erased, and no one is talking about genocide or challenging complicity in it.”

Rajiv Menon KC

Rajiv Menon KC is the barrister acting in defence of one of the first six of the Filton 25 activists to face trial, and has been subjected to unprecedented disciplinary procedures after informing the jury of their own rights.⁶⁶

In his closing speech, Menon, who represented one of the activists, told the jury about the Bushell case, a landmark ruling from 1670 which established the independence of juries.⁶⁷

He read from a plaque at the Old Bailey commemorating the jury in that case, saying “it established the right of juries to give their verdict according to their convictions”.⁶⁸

Justice Johnson had warned defence barristers not to tell the jury that they could reach a verdict according to their conscience, a principle known as jury equity, even though it is their right to do so.⁶⁹

Johnson has referred Menon to contempt proceedings for a second time after the original proceedings were thrown out of court, in a deliberate attempt to intimidate barristers in criminal cases.⁷⁰

Ousman Noor

The Bar Standards Board, upon demands made by UK Lawyers for Israel (UKLFI) have relied on the Terrorism Act to attempt to prosecute barrister Ousman

Noor after he published a legal analysis of Hezbollah’s rights enshrined under international law to armed resistance against the genocidal state of Israel.⁷¹

Attacks on Lawyers

Fahad Ansari

In retaliation for carrying out his lawful professional duties as a lawyer, representing Hamas in the group’s application for de-proscription under Section 4 of the Terrorism Act 2000, the UK state has harassed, intimidated, and abused counter-terrorism powers against lawyer Fahad Ansari.⁷²

The Shadow Secretary of State for Justice also took to social media where he accused Mr. Ansari of supporting terrorism and brought his legal reputation into disrepute, with his comments being widely publicised in various news outlets.⁷³

The Shadow Attorney General also made similar comments on social media. On 6 August 2025, Mr. Ansari was stopped and detained by officers of North Wales Police under Schedule 7 of the Terrorism Act 2000 in a deliberately targeted attack.⁷⁴

During the stop, officers seized Mr. Ansari’s work phone from his car, despite it containing legally privileged and highly sensitive material relating to his national-security and civil-liberties practice.⁷⁵ He was compelled to provide the passcode under threat of arrest.⁷⁶

The device was retained for seven days, during which the entirety of its contents—more than 23,000 files—was downloaded.⁷⁷ 95% of the phone’s contents contained legally privileged or otherwise protected material – of which the police were aware – including communications with clients, witnesses, counsel, experts, journalists and human-rights defenders; case files; images and voice notes.⁷⁸

The following day, while the phone remained in police custody, an attempt was made to access a child family member’s phone via parental-control links associated with the seized device.⁷⁹

Mr. Ansari has issued a legal challenge against the decision to detain him and seize his phone. The High Court has granted the police permission to both rely on secret material and to not disclose the allegations against Mr. Ansari to him or his lawyers, thereby completely undermining the principles of due process and the rule of law.⁸⁰ However, a risk assessment document disclosed by the police falsely identified Mr. Ansari as a member of Hamas, something the police now claim was an error.⁸¹

The police have recently confirmed they have concluded their examination of the contents of the phone and are prepared to delete it but concerns persist that the process is not capable of protecting the confidentiality of client communications, particularly the risk of disclosure of sensitive contacts information that may endanger individuals’ safety.⁸²

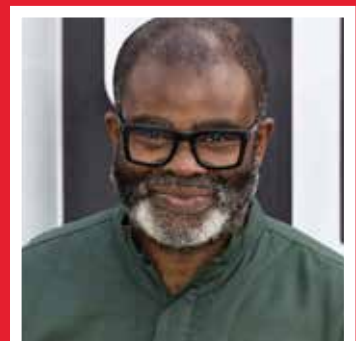
Indeed, the UK state’s mistreatment and intimidation of Mr. Ansari was so severe that five UN Special Rapporteurs raised their concerns over Mr. Ansari’s detention and treatment in a letter to the UK government on 4 February 2026.⁸³

“I’ve organised for Black Lives Matter, championed women’s rights, LGBTQ+ rights, transgender protections, and for the Ukrainians during the war, and no one has had a problem until I started speaking out against Israel’s genocide in Palestine.
